

The Moodle mobile app is designed to help you access your content anywhere at any time on your mobile device.

Access course content online anywhere

You can view videos, interviews, interactions, and text pieces anywhere using your mobile device.

Download content for offline access

You will be able to download your course content, including videos and interactions to view offline. Your progress will then be synced with the platform when you reconnect to the internet.

Receive notifications

You can set your mobile device to allow the app to push notifications about new announcements, assignment deadlines, and other important updates regarding your courses.



What we don't recommend you do with the Moodle app and why

We advise that you still **complete your quizzes, respond to forums, attend class calls, and submit assignments online in our digital classroom and not on the app.** This will ensure your scores and responses are recorded, and no submissions or attempts are lost or delayed.

Complete quizzes



Attempts **may not be recorded**, especially if you are working offline. You may miss the deadline and need to redo the quiz.

Respond to forums (where points are allocated)



Responses **may not be recorded** or may be delayed due to errors in syncing. You may not receive your points.

Submit assignments



The app **does not support all file upload formats**. Your assignment may not upload or could be delayed, and you may miss a deadline.

Attend class calls



Not all the functionality is available on the app. It is advised that class calls are accessed through the classroom.



Please also note that some interactive features may not be available on the app or may not operate effectively in the app, such as interactive activities.

Here is how to download and set up the Moodle app

You need to download the Moodle Mobile app, which is available from the iOS App Store or Android Google Play Store.



Once you have downloaded the Moodle Mobile app, simply follow these steps to connect to Digi Campus:

Select **I'm a learner**.

2

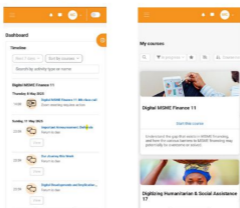
In the site address field, type: <https://campus.digitalfrontiersinstitute.org/learn/my/> and click on **connect**.

You will then be asked for your **Digi Campus username and password**. Type these in and click on **login**.

Your app will then open, and you should see your **Digi Campus Dashboard and courses**.
